#### **Principal's Report**

It was wonderful to see new faces at our P&C meeting on Tuesday night and we hope to see even more at the AGM 6.00pm May 7<sup>th</sup> in the staffroom. This year is a P&C Spring Fair (fete) year and it will be held on September 13<sup>th</sup>.

A Spring Fair sub-committee was formed to continue planning for this year's Fair. This is a huge job and the P&C welcomes anyone who would like to assist. You can choose to participate in just the Spring Fair organisation. The first sub-committee meeting will be held Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> April at 6.00pm in the staffroom. An addition to the school's uniform was also decided at the meeting this week. The grey shorts and trousers will be fazed out to be replaced with black shorts and pants. The black skort will remain. I have been checking daily to ensure that our students are doing this and unfortunately some students are not being as safe as they could be. After a warning, any student not using a helmet will not be able to bring their scooter or bike onto the school grounds.

The P&C has asked that we let everyone know that the canteen will be closed Weeks 1 and 2 of Term 2. Breakfast Club will continue to operate.

It was great to see so many families at the Easter STEAM Night this week. Thank you to Mrs Neyland and all staff who worked so hard to provide this opportunity for our students.




