### CPS Athletics Carnival 2023

Dear Parents/ Carers,

The Cobar Public School Athletics Carnival will be held on **Friday 2nd June 2023 at Ward Oval** commencing at **9.30am**. All students Kinder to Year Six will be attending the carnival. However, children 5 to 7 (and some 8) year old students will be participating in the running age races and novelty events at the CPS Athletics Carnival.

Please note only those students turning **8 this year or older** will be eligible to qualify for the **Nyngbar Carnival to be held in Cobar during Term 3** and the **Western PSSA Athletics Carnival to be held in Dubbo on Friday 15th September, 2023**.

Children will assemble at school as normal and walk to the oval with their house group. We ask that parents encourage their children to participate in the carnival and that students wear: hat, sunscreen, sporting clothes (shirts in house colours: **Chesney- Green**, **Fort Bourke- Yellow**, **Great Cobar- Blue** and **Occidental- Red**, sport shoes and please also bring fluids and lunch plus something to sit on as the grass is often damp at this time of the year. Please ensure all clothing has a name on it. **There will be a special canteen order for this day. Lunch orders will be delivered to Ward oval at 11am. There will be NO canteen at recess**, students will need to pack their recess and other snacks for the carnival.

Please note that all students must wear sports shoes. Spikes can be worn when competing, but must be removed between events.

Events in the Carnival- **All students are expected to compete in their 100m age race. All other track and field events require students to nominate on the form below.** Please be advised that students who have not nominated for an event **by Tuesday 30th May will not be able to compete**. Students are encouraged to nominate for as many events as possible and are able to withdraw on the day.

Events in the Carnival will include:

Field Events: Shot put, Discus, Long Jump and High Jump

Track Events: 100m Age Race, 200m, 800m and 1500m

No physical and verbal harassment of any participant, coach, staff or other spectators will be tolerated. Failure to comply may result in cessation of the event, authorities being called and removal from the venue.

The Department's public liability cover is fault-based and limited to breaches by the department of its duty of care to students that may result in claims for compensation.

Parents and caregivers are advised to assess the level and extent of their child's involvement in the sport program offered by the school, school sport zone, region and state school sport associations when deciding whether additional insurance cover is required prior to their child's involvement in the program. Personal accident insurance cover is available through normal retail insurance outlets.
