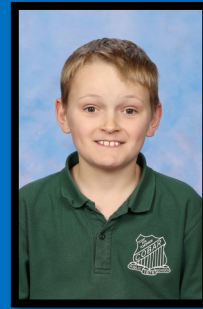


Ashton was very helpful on the Copper Team excursion, Ernie was super impressed with him for helping other students learn to re pack their bags on the excursion.
