Principal's Report

A quiet week across the school this week. The last of the Check-In-Assessments for Literacy and Numeracy were completed and staff began the annual report writing process. Following guidance from the Department, Reports for Semester 2 2021 will be the same as they were for Semester 2 2020.

As soon as we know what format these can take, parents and students will be informed.

Post November 8th all school staff must be fully vaccinated, and full vaccination status is required for visitors to school site. This is not a school level decision; all schools must follow the processes put in place by Departments of Health and Education.


Should you wish to purchase a sibling photograph online, the order must be placed no later than the day before photography day. Sibling photographs will only be taken if an order has been placed.


