Phone Calls

- Friday this week, 9.30-10.30 with myself and the executive team.
- We will answer any general questions you have about what we are doing, plans etc.
- No questions about individual children.
- If you can't make it, video of the Livestream will be uploaded to Facebook and you can comment or ask questions and we will post answers.

Students Attending School.

- Children only need to bring food. This can be brought in a plastic bag, no need for a school bag.
- No drink bottles (we will give them 1 and fill it), or pencils cases, equipment is required, no toys.
- Nothing from outside of school will go into a classroom (only returned work packs).
- Children will work from the same work packs which are being sent home.
- If a work pack is sent home tomorrow and then the child(ren) come to school in the following days, send the work pack with them.
- Everyone to enter through canteen gate, hygiene protocols start there with hand sanitising.
- All indoor and outdoor surfaces cleaned multiple times through the day.
- Regular hand washing throughout the day supervised by teachers.
- 2 classrooms will operate this week, K-2 and Yr 3-6.
- Playground is restricted, no fixed equipment.
- Please do not send a child displaying any illness symptoms.

Work Packs

- Work pack for any children not attending school go out tomorrow.
- Any work which has previously been returned and marked will also go out.
- We will knock on doors and would love to see some smiling critter faces open them up ☺
- We will pick up the work packs you have already if these are left in a bag at the front door.

Continue to look out for each other and those we know might be vulnerable in our Cobar community.
