Principal's Report

This is the final newsletter for 2020; a year which has been more testing for us all than we could ever have imagined as we started school in February. Thank you to our community who have been so supportive of the school as we have navigated our way through this extraordinary year.

Thank you too to our students who displayed remarkable resiliency during their disrupted year. We celebrated the graduation of another year 6 class this week under circumstances which were the best we could provide, but far from normal. Congratulations to our graduating class and we wish you all the best as you move into high school.

Thanks go also to our amazing staff, both teaching and non-teaching. Having heard from many principals about the difficulties they faced this year, I can state categorically that the professionalism and dedication displayed by our staff has been second to none. As we farewell a number of our temporary staff, we thank you for your service to our students and wish you all the best for your futures. To our continuing staff, thank you, enjoy a very well-deserved break and we look forward to working with you again in 2021.

We are planning a number of structural changes to our timetables and processes as we move into the first year of our new 4-year planning cycle. One of these will be a change to our daily timetable. We currently operate with a morning session of 2hrs and 13 minutes, a middle session of 1hr and 40 minutes, and an afternoon session of 1hr. To better meet the needs of students we are going to alter lunch and recess times to make both the morning and middle sessions 2hrs. Lunch will run 11.00-11.47am and recess will run 1.47-2.07pm. Overall instructional time and student break times remain unchanged, as do the start and finish times for our days. Students will continue to have fruit break in the morning session and we will introduce an optional fruit break in the middle session. We believe that this change will allow us more targeted time for explicit instruction.
