

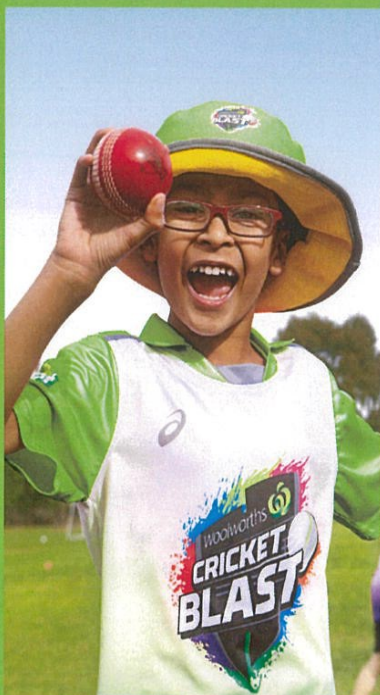

Born in Cobar, went to St John's Catholic School and Cobar High School

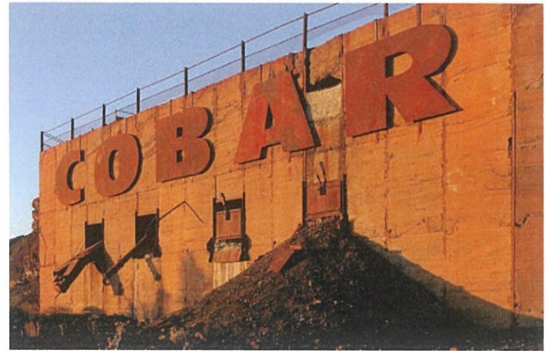
Studied and trained for 3 years in Communications and Theatre/Media at Charles Sturt University - Bathurst
